

#### School start and finish times

## **Meet the Teacher Day**

All parents are very welcome to come and meet their child's teacher on Wednesday 20 September. There will be a presentation and an opportunity to speak to teachers at these times: 3.45 pm, 4.30 pm and 5.15 pm. There are three time slots so that if you have children in more than one class, you will have the opportunity to meet *all* your children's teachers. Just turn up at your child's class at the time slot that suits you.

## Warm weather

In this sunny weather, please send a sunhat into school with your child and apply suncream in the morning – thank you.

## **Pupil Wellbeing**

We know that drop-off times are sometimes just too busy for you to pass on vital information to the class teacher about something that might affect your child's emotional wellbeing. Also, if your child comes to school on the bus or attends Breakfast Club, you need a quick way to inform staff about an issue that they need to know about. For example, if there is an incident at the weekend or if a family situation changes in some way, you may like us to be aware so that we can support your child.

## PE days

On PE days, children will need to wear trainers to school but no longer need to come to school dressed in their PE kit. Please make sure that all PE kit items have your child's name on - your child can leave it on their peg in a suitable bag. We will send PE kits home for washing when required. We will let you know when the PE and swimming days are.

## **Class Assemblies**

Class assemblies will return this academic year and will take place on Friday afternoons at 1.10 pm. Parents will be invited to attend and find out what their child has been learning about! We will soon be sending out the dates in advance so that parents can plan ahead.

# Safeguarding – gate security

The new security system at the front of school will be in operation from Monday 11 September. When visiting the school during the school day, please press the intercom button at the pedestrian gate and we will release it for you to enter and exit.

# **Nut-Free School / Healthy School**

Just a reminder that due to peanut and nut allergies amongst our pupils, we are a nut-free school. Please ensure that lunch boxes do not contain items such as 'Nutella' bars, nut or chocolate spread sandwiches or muesli bars that contain any type of nut or peanut.

Thank you for making your child's lunchbox as healthy as possible.

Just a reminder also that to meet the requirements of being a 'Healthy School', your child's morning snack should be fruit or vegetables and their class-based drink should be water.

## **Breakfast Club**

We are pleased to say that we have managed to keep Breakfast Club at just £1 per session. Please book and pay through ParentPay. If you child is entitled to Free School Meals, there is no charge for breakfast club. However, pupils who receive a free lunch through Welsh Government Universal Provision will still need to pay for breakfast club.

#### Free School Meals

There is a difference between eFSM (eligible for Free School Meals) and UPFSM (Universal Provision for Free School Meals).

- UPFSM is the government initiative to provide free lunches for all pupils currently Reception to year 3.
- eFSM supports families on a low income with free lunches, food in the school holidays, school uniform costs as well as other benefits. School also receives a grant for all pupils who are eligible so if you register, you can help support children with opportunities in school too.

I kindly ask that cars that are *only* dropping off high school students do so at the high school site. Any extra vehicles on the primary car park site cause further congestion.
