Dear parents

We are delighted to confirm we have organised a residential trip for our Year 6 pupils. We recognise how important it is for children's development that they participate in a residential course; time away to develop independence and for some, their first time away from home.

Location: Red Ridge Outdoor Centre, Cefn Coch. Website: [Redridge Centre - Home.](#)

Date: Wednesday 1 May to Friday 3 May.

Time: leave school at 9.00 am on Wednesday, arrive back at approximately 5.30 pm on Friday.

Daytime activities: high ropes, kayaking, stand up paddle boarding, archery, caving, rock climbing and abseiling.

Evening activities: hill walking, orienteering and disco.

Specialist equipment needed: sleeping bag.

Food: sample menu:

Breakfast - a choice of cereals followed by a full English breakfast - bacon or sausage, fried or scrambled egg, tomatoes, spaghetti hoops or beans, toast and jam or marmalade.

Lunch - sandwiches made by the guests from food that the centre provides - bread, cheese, cooked meats, salad, pickles, mayonnaise, chocolate spread, jams, oranges or apples, crisps or biscuits.

Evening meal is a two-course meal and will vary from week to week. Sample menus: 1) lasagne, garlic bread, coleslaw, tinned fruit and ice cream; 2) fish fingers, chips, salad, syrup sponge and custard; 3) roast chicken, stuffing, roast potatoes, vegetables, gravy, apple crumble and custard.

Specialist diets are well catered for.

Cost: The estimated cost is £197.00, dependant on final number of children attending. We will notify you of the actual cost as soon as possible. The amount is payable on ParentPay please. This trip will be partially grant funded for children entitled to free school meals; please see your ParentPay account for details. All monies are to be received by 30 April, payable by instalments if you wish.

The centre will be aware of any allergies and that we are a nut-free school. There will be a meeting on Wednesday 24 January at 6.00 pm in the school hall to explain details of the trip and answer any questions you may have. The manager of the Outdoor Centre will join us to answer any questions.

Please fill in the attached form and return to school by Friday 26 January to express your child's intent to attend the residential.
