The safeguarding of pupils is paramount at Ysgol Gynradd Llanidloes. Staff, parents and governors are committed to providing the safest possible environment where children can learn with confidence.

As a visitor to our school, please take some time to read the following safeguarding information in order to keep everyone safe at all times:

- Visitors are required to sign in and sign out at the office hatch.
- Visitors are required to wear a visitors' badge at all times. Please collect a badge when you sign in and return it to when you sign out.
- The names of the *Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSLs)* are displayed on posters around the school. If you have any safeguarding concerns during your visit, please inform one of the DSLs immediately.
- Please take time to read the evacuation procedure; on hearing the fire alarm, please leave the building via the nearest safe exit.
- Visitors are not permitted to use mobile phones in the presence of children.
- Visitors are not permitted to enter the children's cloakrooms or toilets unaccompanied; if you are carrying out maintenance which requires you to enter a cloakroom or toilet area, please speak to the office staff.
- Please shut / lock doors and gates behind you as you found them. Padlocks on external gates should not be left unlocked, even for a short time, without prior arrangement with the office.
- Please do not let any other person into the main entrance; a member of staff will be happy to help.
